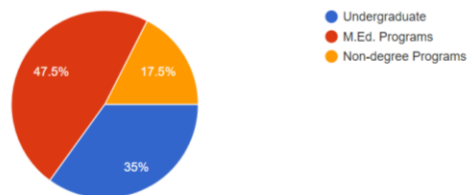

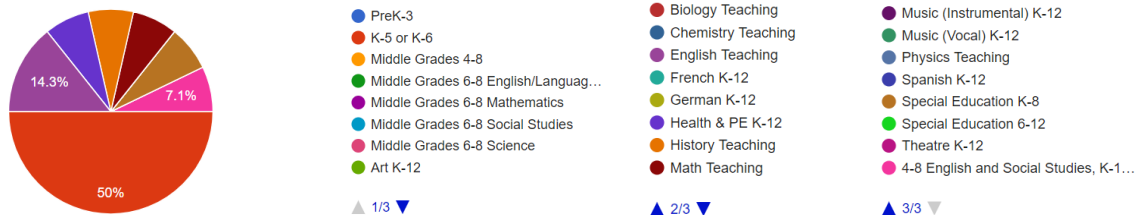

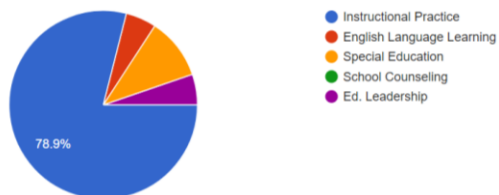
Choose your undergraduate major

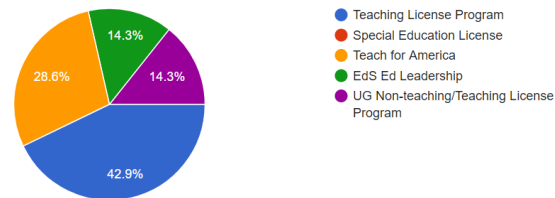

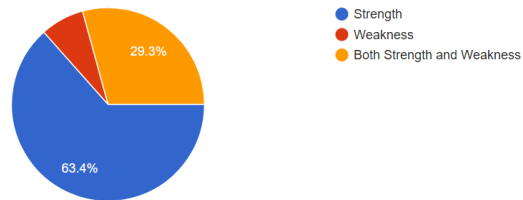

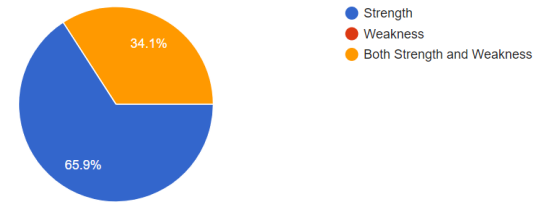
Was your preparation in Planning and Content Knowledge a strength and/or weakness?

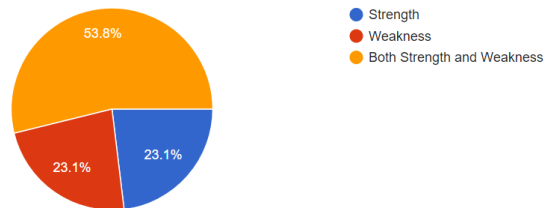
Was your preparation in Teaching Strategies a strength and/or weakness?

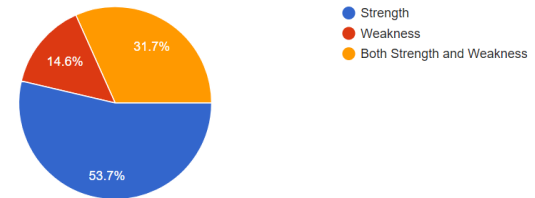
Was your preparation in Assessment/Grading/Testing a strength and/or weakness?

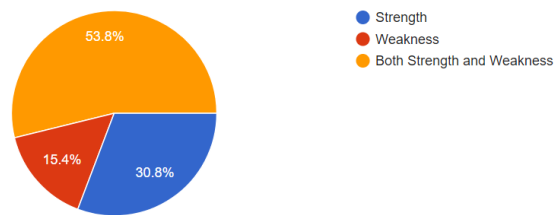

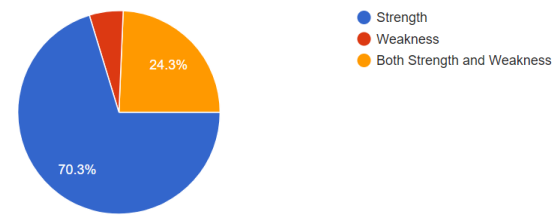

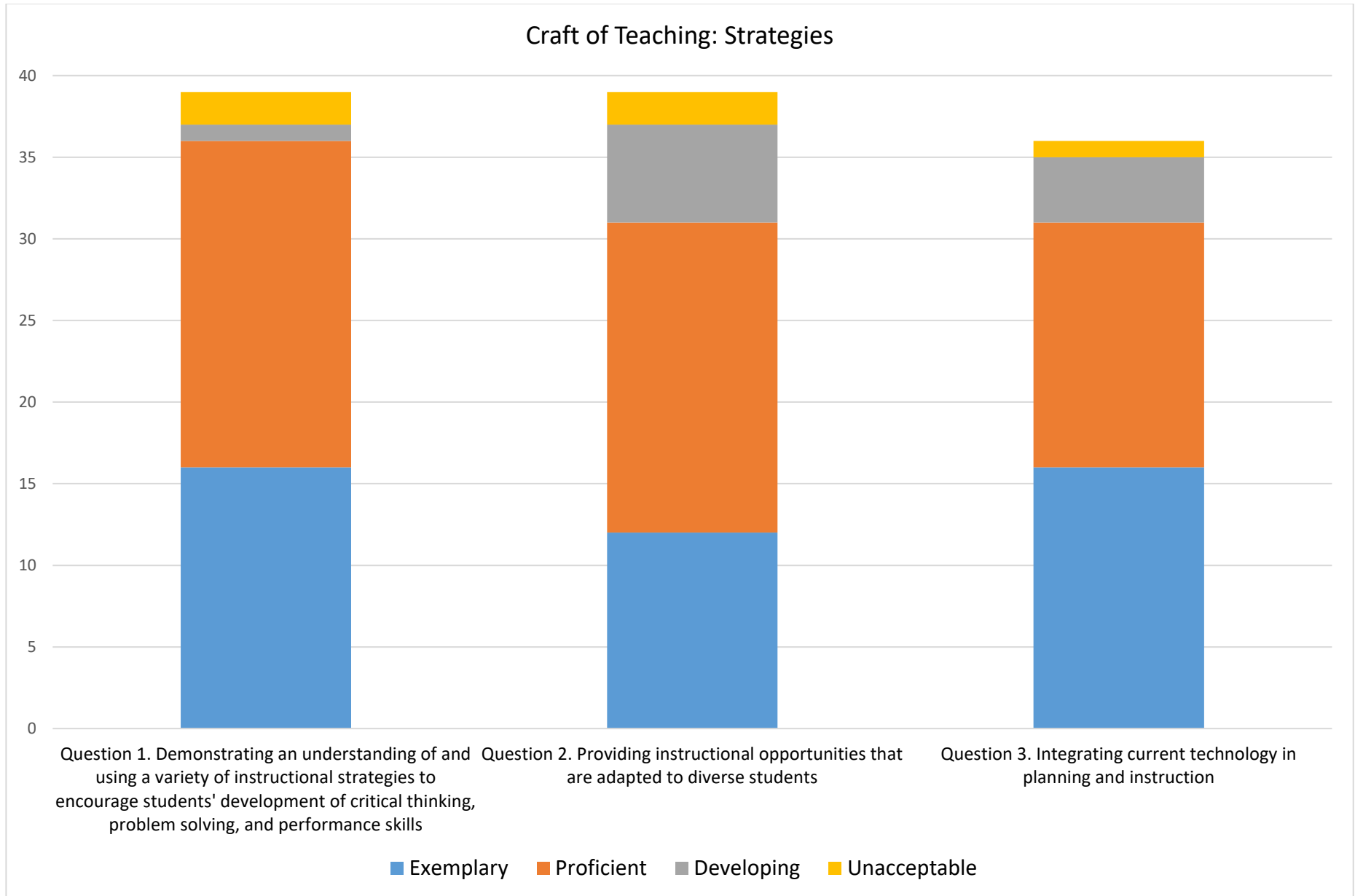

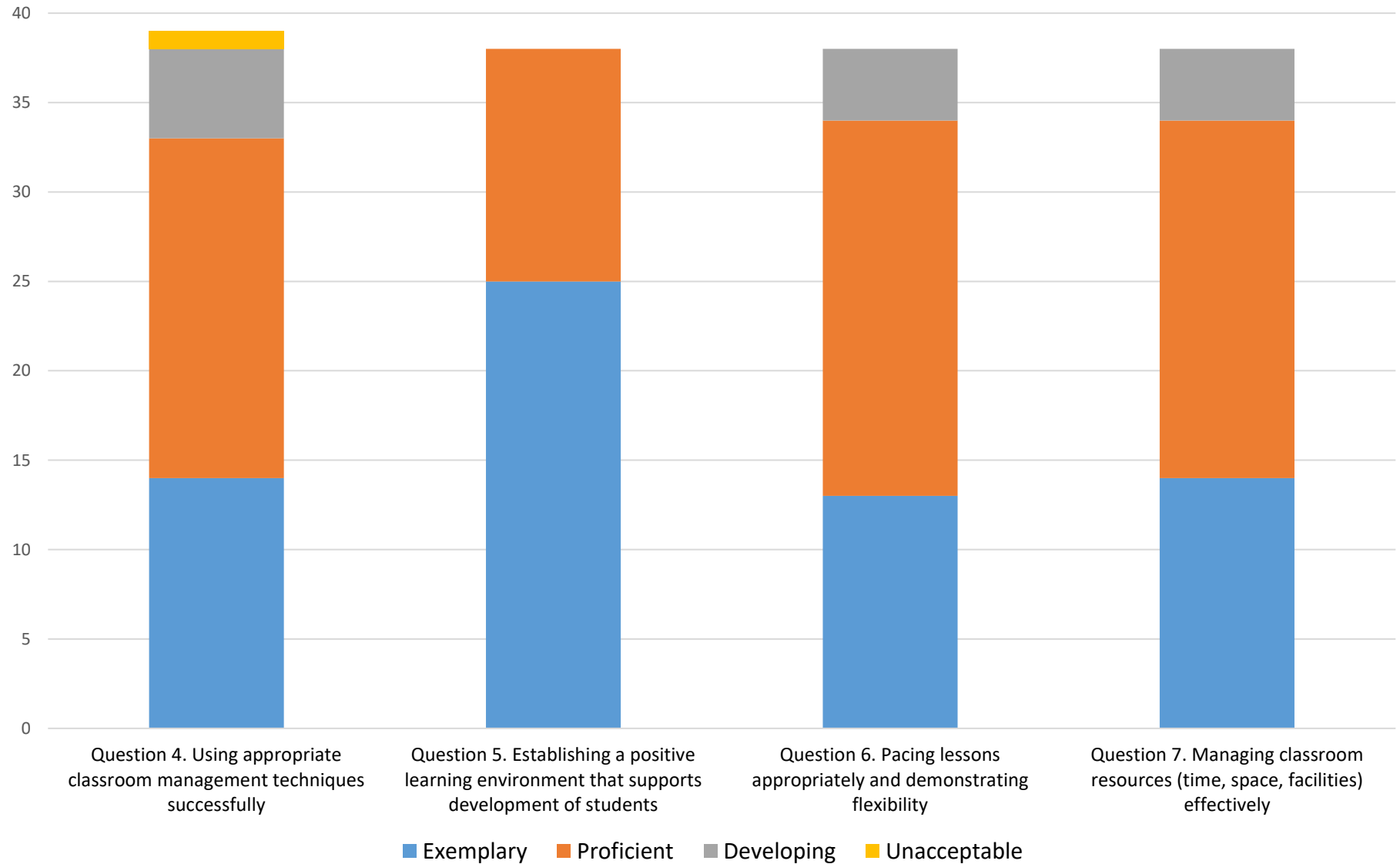

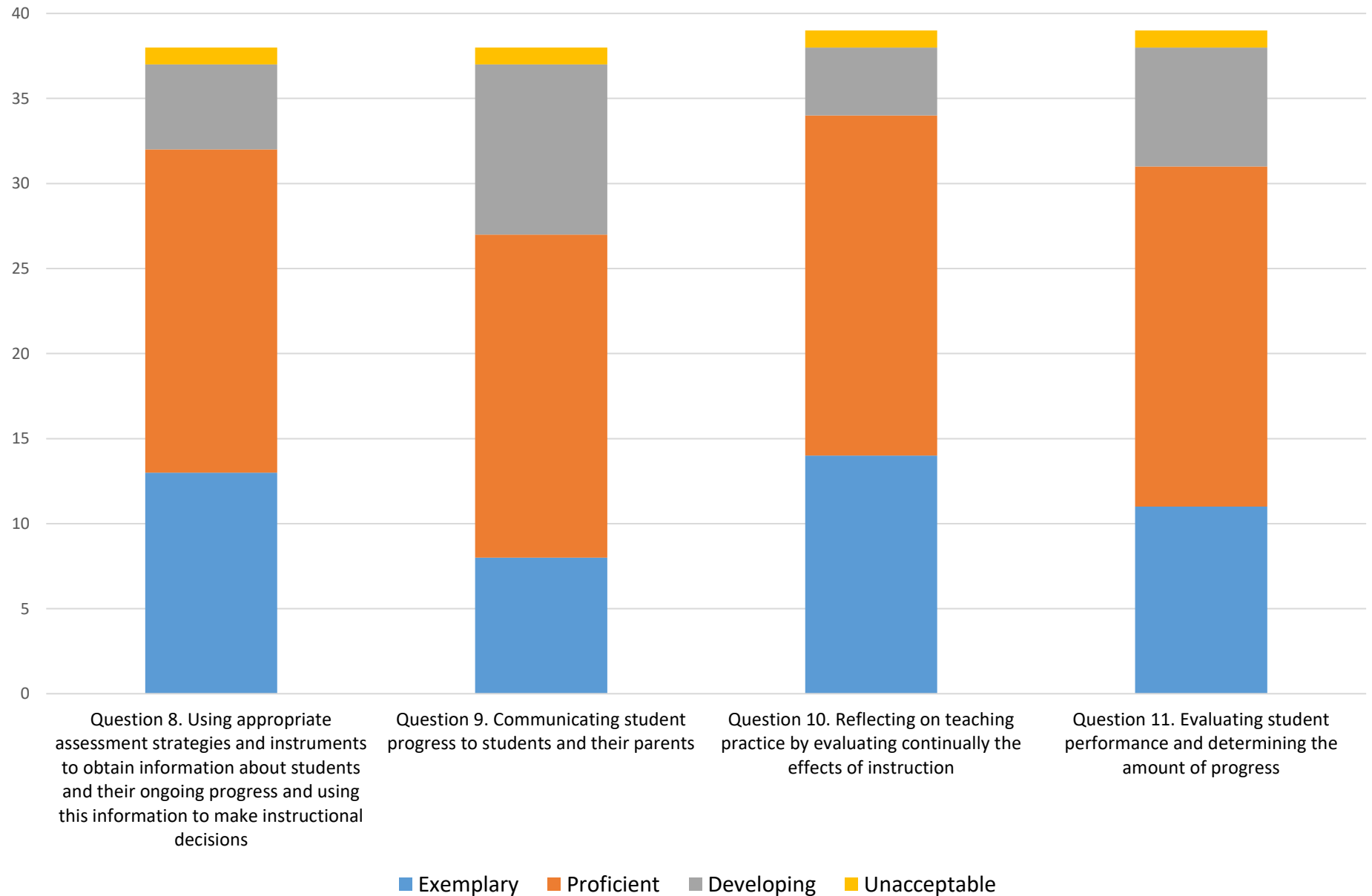

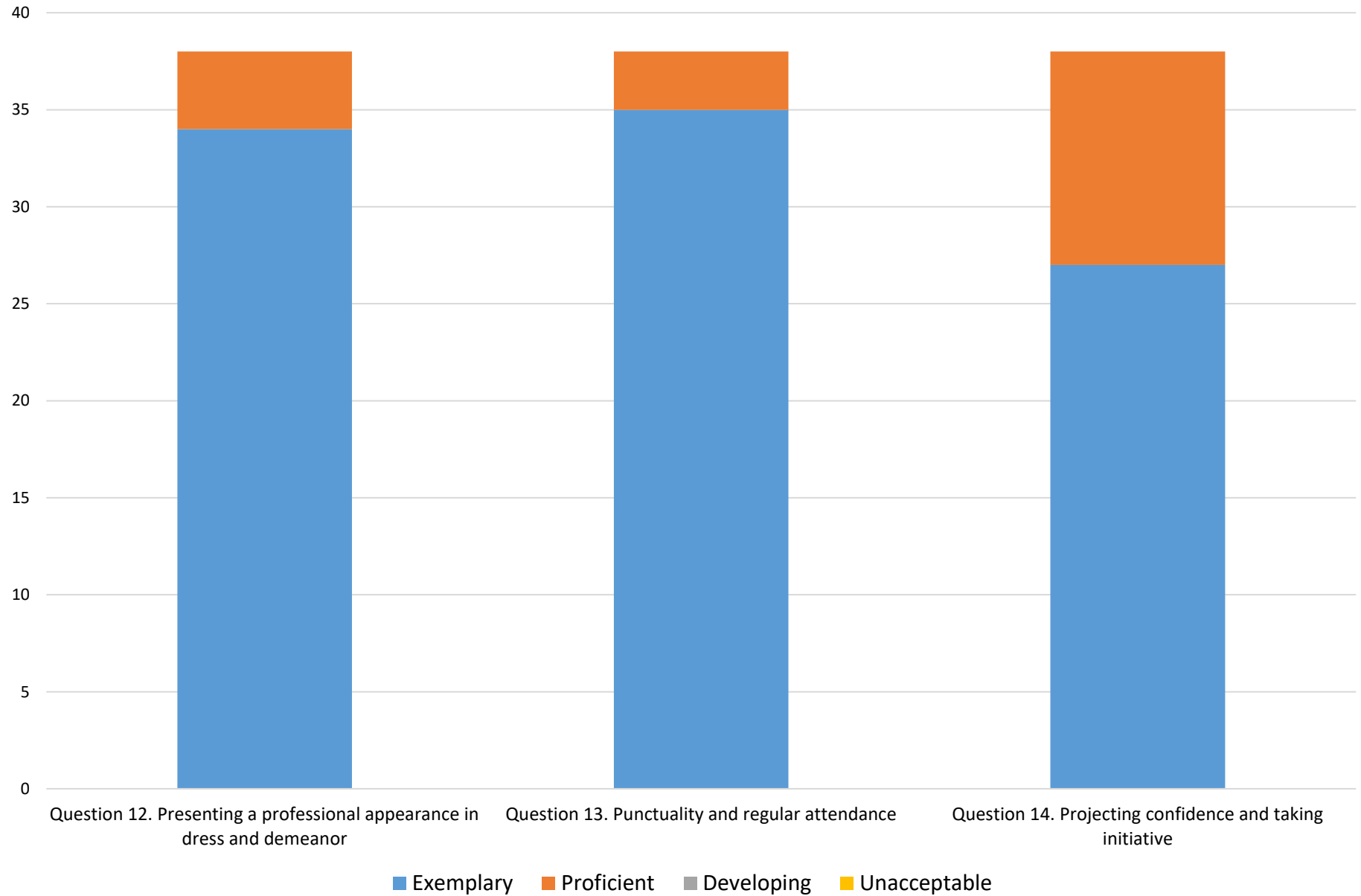
Craft of Teaching: Learning Environment



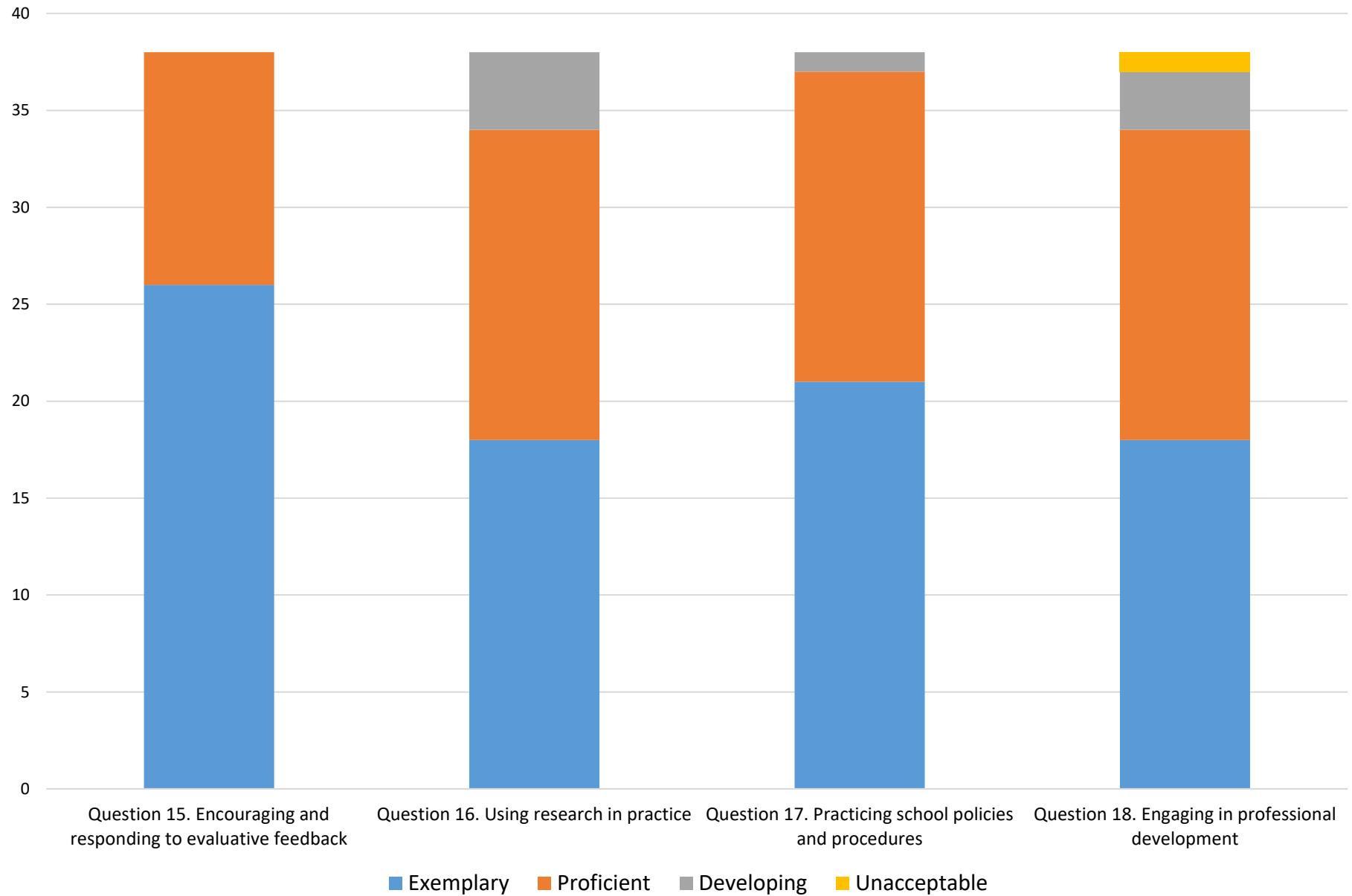
Completer Survey Data - Craft of Teaching: Assessment and Evaluation



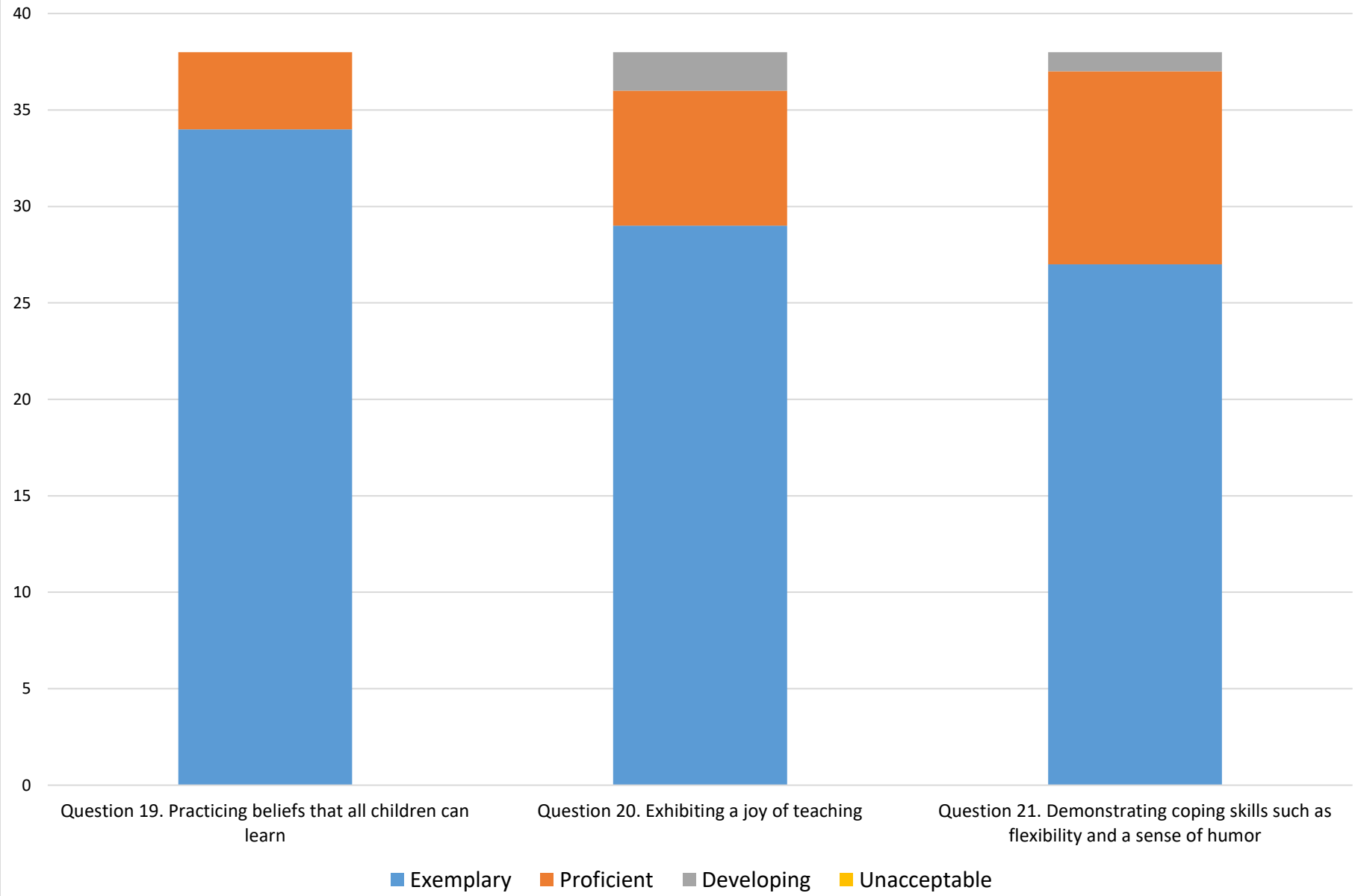

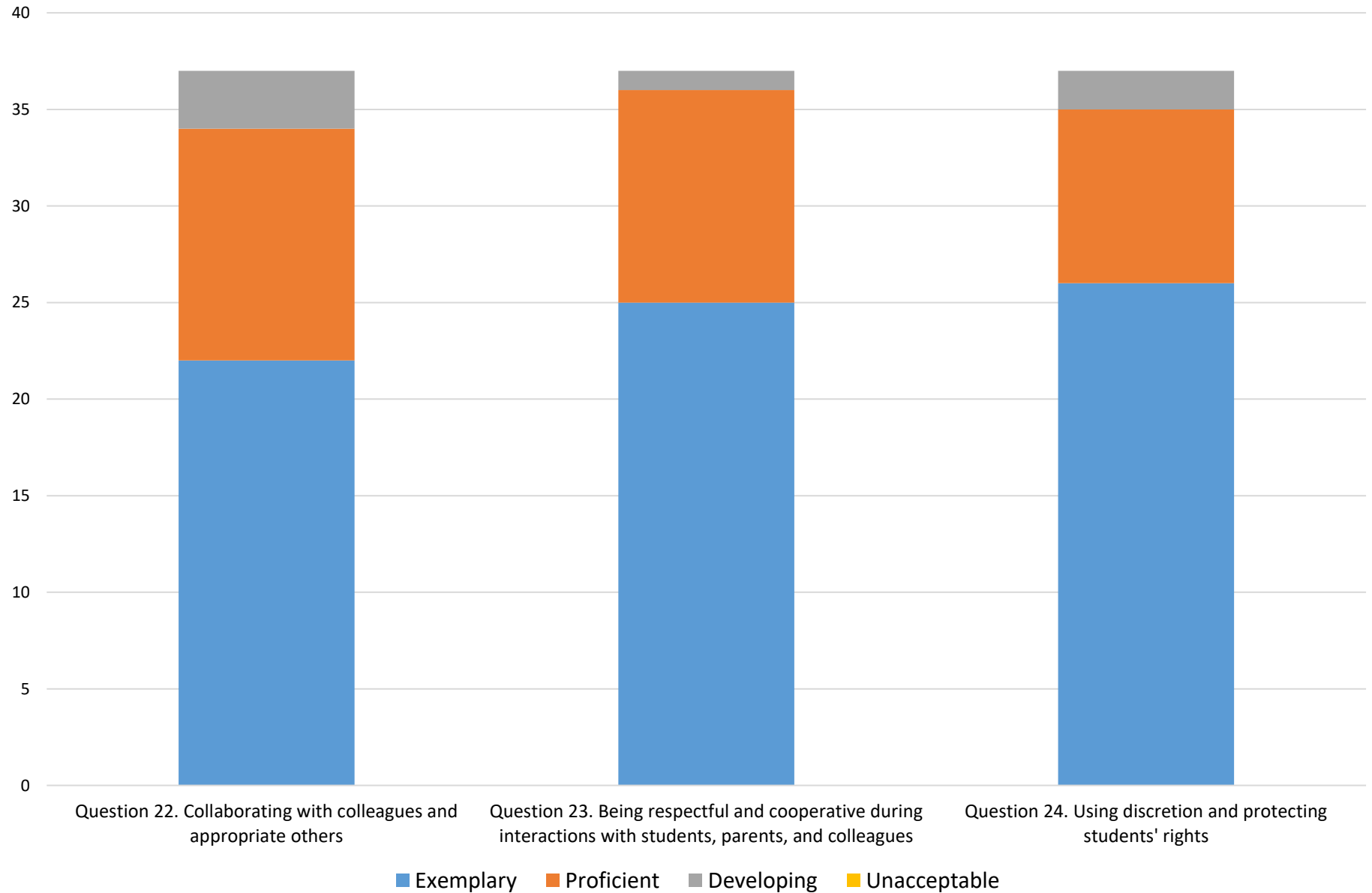

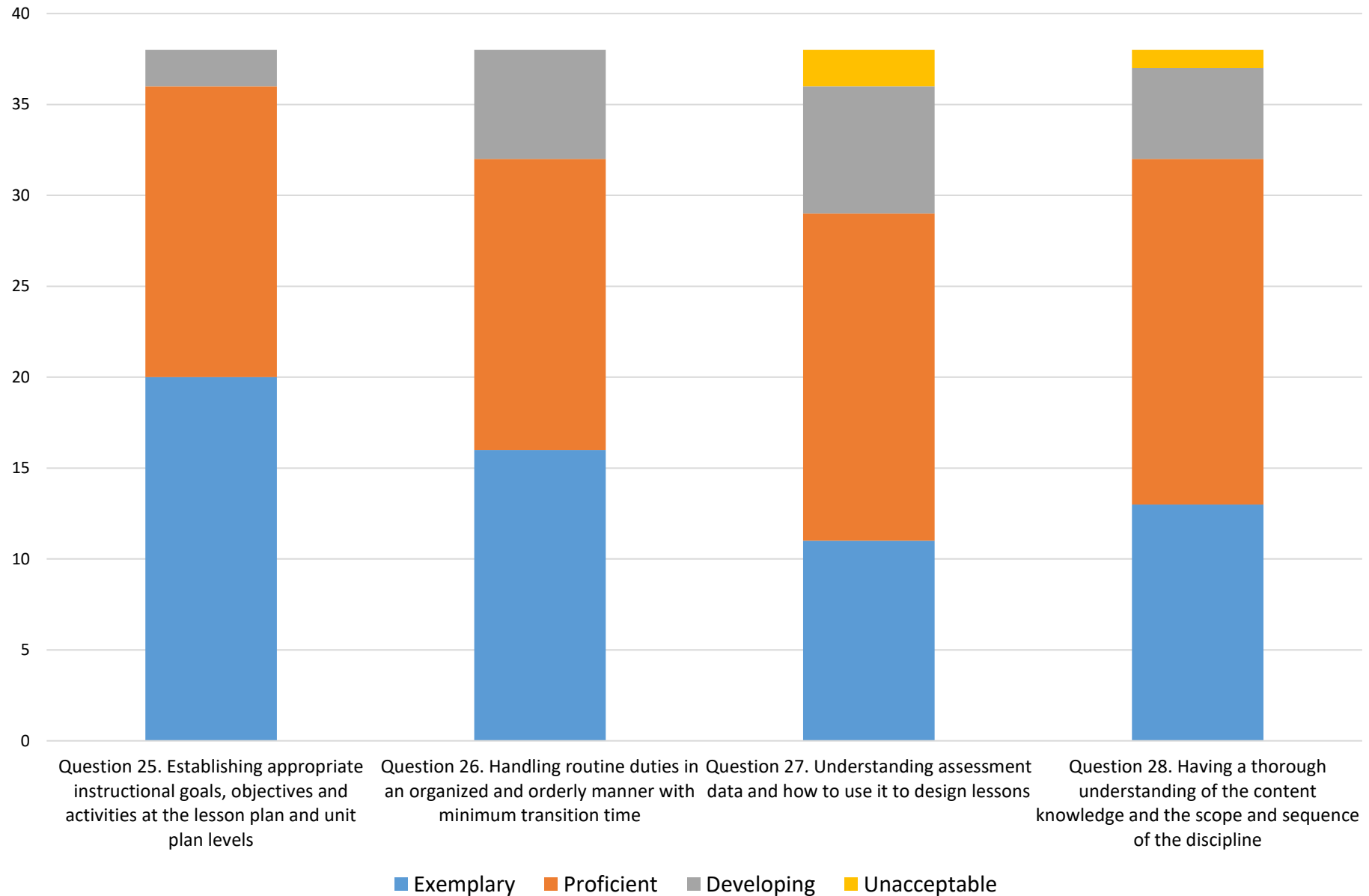
